

## 19. REQUIREMENT FOR ALTERATION TO AN EXISTING DESIGNATION

### PURPOSE OF REPORT

1. The purpose of this report is to present the report and recommendation of Commissioner Max Barber who considered a requirement by Transit New Zealand to alter an existing designation in the Christchurch City Plan.

### EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

2. Transit New Zealand gave notice of a requirement to alter its designation for the intersection of Halswell Road/State Highway 75 and Dunbars Road Christchurch. The notice affects both the general State Highway designation and a road widening designation. The proposed works involve the construction, operation and maintenance of traffic signals at the intersection and associated changes to the road layout including the widening of the carriageway and the introduction of a slip lane. The notice also seeks an alteration to the designation boundary to include additional land.
3. Two submission were received in response to the public notification of the notice of requirement.
4. Mr Max Barber was appointed to hear the matter and he did so on 2 May 2008. His report and recommendation is attached. His recommendation is that the Council recommend to Transit New Zealand that it confirm its notice of requirement subject to a number of conditions.
