PURPOSE OF REPORT

1. The purpose of this report is to present the report and recommendations of Commissioner David Collins who heard submissions on Plan Change 28 to the City Plan.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

- 2. Plan Change 28 is a private change initiated by Kennaway Park Joint Venture Partnership. It seeks the rezoning of approximately 30 hectares of land bounded by Tunnel Road, the Heathcote River and the existing industrial development off Kennaway Road, to enable commercial/industrial activities to be established.
- 3. The site is currently zoned Special Purpose (Ferrymead). This zoning was established in 1999 as an interim measure to allow further investigation into an appropriate zoning pattern for the area. The Rural 2 zone rules apply to land zoned Special Purpose (Ferrymead). The plan change requests that Council rezone the site as Business 4.
- 4. Public notification of the plan change on 22 November 2008 attracted 49 submissions. Mr David Collins was appointed as Commissioner and conducted a hearing over five days in June 2009. His report, which recommends that the plan change be approved with modifications, has been separately circulated.

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

5. Approval of the Commissioner's recommendation will not result in any additional expenditure. If an appeal is lodged against the decision the Council would need to be represented at the Environment Court. Such representation can be accommodated within existing budgets.
