## 2. REVISED EARTHQUAKE-PRONE, DANGEROUS AND INSANITARY BUILDINGS POLICY

Councillor Wells briefed the Council on this item, on behalf of the Hearings Panel on the Earthquake-Prone, Dangerous and Insanitary Buildings Policy 2010. The Council agreed to the following amendments to Attachment 1 to the agenda:

- Paragraph 1.2.5, first line replace "dangerous" with "insanitary".
- Paragraph 2.3.6 second line amend to read "required to ensure structural strength".

It was **resolved** unanimously on the motion of Councillor Wells, seconded by Councillor Button, that the Council:

- (a) Adopt the revised Earthquake-Prone, Dangerous and Insanitary Buildings Policy attached as Attachment 1 to the agenda (as amended).
- (b) Note that further analysis, in particular relating to the categories and timeframes for strengthening, will be undertaken for Council to consider whether to issue a further revised Policy for consultation in 2011.
