#### PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 2. In 2011/12, the total pool available for allocation for the Metropolitan Discretionary Response Fund is \$145,057. At the time of writing, there is \$113,366 remaining in the Metropolitan Discretionary Response Fund for 2011/12.
- The purpose of the Fund is to assist community groups where the project and funding request falls outside other Council funding criteria and/or closing dates. This fund is also for emergency funding for unforeseen situations. Applications requesting over \$15,000 require consideration by the Metropolitan Funding Committee. Staff have delegated authority to consider applications for less than \$15,000.
