- (a) Recommend to the Minister of Lands that part of Mandeville Street shown as Sections 1 and 2 on the attached scheme plan, containing approximately 504 metres squared (subject to survey) be declared to be stopped by consent pursuant to Section 116(2)(b) (i) and (ii) of the Public Works Act 1981.
- (b) Agree that pursuant to Section 345 (1) (a) (i) of the Local Government Act 1974 the land be sold to the adjoining owner of Unit 7A being Colin Lester Rhodes, Glennis Patricia Rhodes and David Leonard Philpott.
- (c) Declare that Section 3 on the attached scheme plan be surplus and sold to the adjoining owner of Unit 7A being Colin Lester Rhodes, Glennis Patricia Rhodes and David Leonard Philpott.
- (d) Agree that the sale be subject to the purchaser entering into an encumbrance in favour of the Christchurch City Council restricting the further sale and use of the land except in conjunction with Unit A DP 48501.
- (e) Agree that all services running through the road to be stopped be protected by service easements.
