Your Submission:

Streets and Transport (cycling).

The Council should do more to encourage cycle use as Christchurch is ideal as a cycling city. Very little is done to encourage this mode when compared to private cars and public transport, and the returns from investment in cycling are high. With the development of the new bus interchange, the City Council should look at using part of the existing interchange as a secure cycle stand/storage area, with hire-able lockers, free bike stands (cages), showers and changing sheds. The CCC could enter into a partnership with a cycle retailer to support this venture through leasing part of the exchange to them for their business, and cafe's could be encouraged as well.

Money needs to be set aside in the LTCCP to cater for this type of development.
