Your Submission:	<p>The outcomes for the LTCCP are not being achieved, ie, a safe city. There are air quality concerns that appear to have come about due to systemic failure.</p> <p>The CU3 zone Phillipstown School should be actively protected as a sensitive site.</p> <p>The regulations pertaining to the current B3B 'buffer' zone between Phillipstown School and Tuam Street needs to be enforced.</p> <p>All discharges to air within the Phillipstown B3B zone should be identified and monitored.</p> <p>A replacement for the original Cross Street reserve public swimming pool is essential. The lack of recreational and instructional aquatic facilities in this area is of concern. This is closely linked to local and national information which show a need for children to learn to swim to avoid the appalling drowning statistics.</p>
