<b>Your Submission:</b>	<p>We want the Council to seriously consider greater heritage protection and funding. Action should include protecting Pre 1940 buildings from demolition throughout Christchurch, we need rules not guidelines for people to follow, strict rules. Increased funding to save our built heritage is greatly needed but just consider the least expensive way for the Council to save heritage would be just to change the rules to PROTECT our built heritage. We are losing too many residential and commercial buildings early workers cottages, villas and art deco buildings. Buildings are under threat, for example The Occidental could go at any stage, presently it has been vandalised and could be the next to go by DEMOLITION BY NEGLECT, as 281 Cambridge Terrace Ti Kouka an 1865 building was lost by fire on the 21st of April. The house was for a number of years greatly neglected by the owners and needed Council protection. Please consider adding greater heritage protection to the LTCCP.</p>
