**Your Submission:**

We would like the ChCh City Council to have the Lyttelton Waste Water removed from Lyttelton Harbour and directed through to Bromley for final treatment and release from the outfall.

Residents and engineers are aware, due to the terrain in the Lyttelton Harbour Basin, it is not ideally suitable for Land Application of waste water. It is fraught with difficulties which will cause ongoing problems with the system and could escalate the cost much higher than it already is.

Land Application is the most expensive option but also has a high degree of 'unknowns' relating to the environment, soil tolerance, erosion and odour. It is also removing land which in most cases is being used in primary production in a sustainable manner.

Bromley is a proven system that works well and with the upgrade and new outfall, can more than adequately support the extra amount of waste water from Lyttelton harbour, at a lot less cost.
