To whom it may concern.

I write on behalf of the 76 members of the Purau Moorings Association Inc and many other members of the general public.

The Purau Jetty is an essential structure that has a large amount of use.

On any given day it is used by boat owners to embark to their boats and at suitable tides load or offload passengers and goods.

The jetty is a popular base for many young people to enjoy that enduring pastime fishing.

Purau Bay is a well used venue for education purposes, and school parties fossicking around the bay and jetty are a common sight.

With an ever increasing population the jetty will be essential for future Ferry services. In its present state it is not suitable as it is exposed and in a questionable state of repair.

The Purau Moorings Association Inc has long held the vision of a suitable extension to the jetty. This would possibly take the form of greater length seaward to enable use during most or all states of the tide. It would end in a T shape so vessels, both commercial and private could lie in the lee of the structure if wind or swell dictates.

We look forward to further dialogue on this matter.

PURAU MOORINGS ASSOCIATION INCORPORATED

RULES

1. Name

The name of the association shall be 'Purau Moorings Association Incorporated'.

2. Aims and Objectives

- a. To represent and voice the common interests of the mooring and boat owners of Purau Bay.
- b. To promote all aspects of water safety in Purau Bay, especially as they pertain to moored craft.
- c. To cooperate with other organisations and with organisations having objectives similar to the Association.
- d. To improve security of the craft moored in Purau Bay through:
 - i. Helping to establish social networks between boat owners.
 - ii. Establishing formal contact with the Residents Association, Police, Harbour Board, Navy, Coastguard, and other Associations.
- e. To promote the improvement of recreational boating facilities at Purau Bay initially focussing on dinghy storage, building a wharf, a careening pad, car parking, shore side electricity and fresh water.
- f. To promote membership in the Association.
- g. To do all such things as may from time to time appear desirable to the Association.
