Your Submission:

At the most recent meeting of the Central Riccarton Residents' Association residents identified several priorities for the Central Riccarton area.

Community Garden - this will require the acquisition of land, or gifting of land from the Council.

Beautification - there is a perception that the Central Riccarton area has been neglected by the Council and that more money needs to be invested in the area. In particular a beautification project and more seating in parks and more generally better upkeep in the area.

Waste Water Overflow - this is a major issue in the Wharenui School area and more generally in areas of increased intensification in the Central Riccarton area. Waste water and other infrastructure is being put under increased pressure from subdivision and intensification. Council needs to better plan for the future (infrastructure in this area), and externalise the costs onto developers.
