I am the Junior Club Captain at Sumner Rugby so it would be accurate to say I have a foot in both camps making this submission as in individual (parent whose children play rugby) and as a Rugby Administrator who understand the need for the ongoing improvements to the Pavilion. I want the council to consider favourably any application for funding for any further developments to the Pavilion.
