Your Submission:	<p>I am disabled to a certain extent and need to use a mobility scooter to travel around the city. I appreciate the difficulty of the maintenance of city and suburban footpaths, but find that when electricity or phone companies and so on dig up part of a pavement to install equipment, it is sometimes many months before such 'digs' are repaired to their proper smoothness, either by tarseal or concrete. This makes it extremely difficult for people like myself on mobility wheelchairs, and also for people pushing prams or other wheelchairs to negotiate.</p> <p>Could there not be a regulation passed to oblige companies or individuals who dig into a public footpath to make proper repairs within a certain, short space of time?</p>
