As one who cycles to and from work most days, I appreciate the network of cycle ways and cycle lanes. Three ways in which I would like to see these improved are =

1. Regular sweeping for broken glass, especially after weekends. The inconvenience and cost of frequent puncture repairs threatens to drive me back to using the car.

2. Find alternative locations to place temporary "Road Works" signs. These are nearly always placed in cycle lanes, at about head-height for riders. They force cycles into the carriageway.

3. Parking wardens please pay greater heed to: a) persistent double-parking in inner-city streets, e.g. Gloucester St, between Colombo St and Oxford Tce.

b) cars, vans and trucks, plus trailers and boat trailers, parked across cycle lanes in the suburbs.

As for 2 (above), these parking infringements force cyclists into the carriageway. This imperils cyclists and alarms motorists.
