Your Submission:

The section of Governors Bay Road between my driveway (#869) to where the footpath begins near Main Road is a hazard to many road users but in particular pedestrians. This narrow stretch of road is shared by speeding motorcycles, boy racers as well as runners, walkers, cyclists and the few motorists who obey the 50kmh speed limit. The police tell me they cannot monitor this stretch of road because the straight is not long enough to allow them to calibrate their instruments. A footpath would provide some protection from speeding vehicles and they may slow down if the road appeared less like a section of open road.

I would like to see a safe footpath, with kerb and channel constructed from the corner of numbers 863, 865, 867 & 869 to meet the existing footpath. This would also drain the water that currently pools at the side of the road.

This should be done for the safety of pedestrians using this stretch of road.
