<b>Your Submission:</b>	<p>The Association supports the extension of the Tram through High to Lichfield into Poplar to Tuam to High streets back to city centre subject to receipt of detailed plans showing stops parking &amp; clearances down Poplar Street and on a minimum disruption construction programme. We also support the later extension to and beyond the Poltech.</p> <p><b>CAR PARKING</b></p> <p>We wish the Council to improve both the supply and cost of parking in and about lower High Street by negotiating with the owners and or lessees for the 300 vehicle parking building in Bedford Row to allow the 1st hour parking free as with other car parks in the central City. This cost could be covered by the substantial parking meter revenue from our area and or from the Central City Revitalisation Fund.</p>
