I wish to support the Charteris Bay Residents Association's submission to the C.C.'s draft Long Term Council Plan regarding the Charteris Bay Water + Wastewater Scheme.

The wastewater septic tank and field drainage system is nearly 20 years old and although it works reasonably well in the dry season it frequently discharges out of the air vents at the end of the field piping when the ground surrounding the trenches is soaked by rain in the winter. (My apologies! This system is on my property at 60 Bayview Rd).

There is the required ~~walling~~ wall and sealing to prevent any of the effluent moving further down the sloping section. But I feel that any further delay in implementing the proposed waste water scheme would be detrimental to the health + well being of the community.

Regarding our water supply collection, although it has not "killed" us yet, it is open to condemnation from birds and opossums and other deastics.
