Significance Policy:

I am concerned that the proposed significance policy will limit public consultation. I don't believe that there is any need for urgent or commercially sensitive issues to be exempted from special consultation procedures. I submit that these clauses be removed from the proposed significance policy.

Cycling:

I encourage the council to continue to improve the cycle network within the city centre and the suburbs. There are still many major roads which are dangerous to cycle along, such as Riccarton Road. While encouraging the public to switch to more sustainable transport modes is included in the plan this is not reflected in the council's targets, which are only to maintain the currently levels of walkers and cyclists. I suggest that these be amended to show an increase over the next three years. It would be great to see more cycling stands provided in the city centre.
