Your Submission:

I am writing this submission to complain about the fact that I have already approached Michael Thomson, 3 times from Greenspace, and Gail Sherrif, City Councillor.

I had a fall on the 12 May 2008 on some uneven tiles, and Asphalt, on the corner of Shaw Avenue and Seaview Road, outside SBA Accounting business, on the corner.

Michael Thomson told me that the problem had been fixed back in July/AUGust last year but when I went to inspect this had not been done, on another phone call to him he said it was an outside contractors fault that they had charged the council to repair the problem, but they had actually not carried out the work need to repair this problem. He told me at that time that the tiles were going to be uplifted and a bark garden would be put in to replace these tiles, and that the Asphalt would be repaired, as of todays date and 11 months after my original complaint, I find it very upsetting that this problem has still not been rectified, I sent photos of the area concerned with my original letter. I observed an elderley person last week when I was in the area, trip on these very same tiles, that are now being pushed up further by the tree roots, I think that it is time us ratepayers were given a fair go and that something should immediately be done about this problem, Thanking you I await your reply.
