Key concerns:

1. Traffic congestion;
2. Sewerage, garbage, pollution;
3. Long term building/development;
4. Beautification;
5. Public amenities, facilities & activities;
6. Crime.

Traffic congestion - long term plan required to relieve and / or prevent traffic congestion worsening (eg, increase speedlimit on causeway, bus lanes);

Sewerage/Pollution - LTP to reduce and eliminate (as far as possible) pollution in Sumner;

LTBD - requires a set of rules to allow flexibility and proper consultation on any major development in Sumner. For example, commercial buildings, building a supermarket, skate park, public swimming pool etc;

Beautification - Any LTD should be required to "enhance" Sumner aesthetically - even commercial development. The causeway through to Sumner's esplanade walkway needs to be beautified for long term enjoyment (eg, plantings, walkways, artificial reef, natural sand dunes etc);

Public Amenities - LTD needs to consider public enjoyment of the sea, beach and surrounds for ALL age groups (eg, skate park, underage entertainment, festivals, beachfront markets ref: Lyttelton Market; public swimming pool/spa; tracks/walkways);

Crime - community constables, neighbourhood watch, more youth activities (eg, community surfing, swimming, lifesaving), "big brother" programme, volunteer youth groups (eg, planting via council, elderly aid/assistance).
