Your Submission:

I support the extension of the Tram Route to Barbadoes Street

I support the inter generational approach for funding City infrastructure

I support the establishment of a new library in Linwood. However I request that consideration be given to bringing construction forward to the 2010/2011 year.

I support the plans to develop neighbourhood parks.
However I request that adequate resources are provided in the LTCCP to maintain existing parks and reserves. For example excellent work has been done in constructing a sealed car park and hard surfaced walkways in the Charlesworth reserve. I think more effort should go into maintaining the walkways by ensuring these are re metalled at periodic intervals. Likewise because release cutting of vegetation is not provided many of the native plants added to this reserve, many planted by volunteers, are dying and this is a waste of resources.

I note on page 9 of the Summary document under the heading "Where the money goes" that funds are spent on "Computer and Communications" costs.

With the Council moving soon into a new building there is a one of opportunity to reduce spending on Information and Communications Technology (ICT) services. While details of this type of spend are not detailed in the plan I have been advised that the budget for 2008/09 is "around \$27 Million"
