We are the Owner of the properties known as Holiday Inn City Centre on the corner of Cashel Street, High Street and the adjoining retail shops on High Street.

We are supportive of both the proposed Options A and B of the tram extensive. We believe that extending the tram down High Street towards the Polytechnic has many positive linkages for the City particularly it provides an important tourist link to High Street and the Lanes revitalization which is currently a City focus. We would like to see these works completed sooner than the indicated timeframes.

Our support for the tram extension is conditional on:

1. That the operation of the tram and/or construction of the tram route do not cause excess noise late at night when our guests will be trying to sleep. At the meeting Wednesday 25th March 2009 the tram operators gave their assurance that the tram would operate no later than 9.00pm-9.30pm. We support the extension based on the assurance that the trams will not operate after 9.30pm.
2. That we are consulted on any possible tram stop locations and structures within close proximity to the Holiday Inn City Centre. We are supportive of a tram stop on the Council Reserve on the corner of Cashel and High Street but request further consultation on the on both the location of stops and any associated structures to be constructed.
3. That car parking is retained on High Street between Cashel and Lichfield Streets. This car parking is crucial to our retail shops. Please note that we are currently planning to refurbish these shops including a new shop-front.
4. That we are consulted with about the location of the tram tracks in the road outside our properties.
